PRIZE MONEY will be paid out by cheque within three weeks after the Show.

Please print clearly on Entry Form **Prize Money Cheques Payable to.....**

Cheques not banked within 6 months of date of issue will be cancelled with no further recourse.

REFUNDS – 75% of entry fees will be given in valid circumstances where written notification has been received at the Show office before 5pm on Thursday 8th March 2018.

This notification must be accompanied by a detailed doctor's or veterinarian's certificate.

All horses/ponies must appear sound i.e. no movement impediment or unevenness in the opinion of the Judge or Chief Steward. Refunds will be paid by cheque within three weeks after the Show.

HEIGHT CERTIFICATES & PERFORMANCE CARDS – A photocopy of the current NZ RAS Height Certificate & Performance Card must accompany entries for entry to be accepted. In any Height Class the current NZ RAS Height Certificate must be presented to both the Gate Steward and Ring Steward on request.

Height Certificates required for the following:

Where classes are defined by height, competitors/exhibitors must carry a current RAS Certificate for their horse/pony.

NOVICE QUALIFICATIONS are as at show day. Please advise the Secretary if you should win your way out of a class after entry and before show day, we will adjust your entry accordingly.

SUBSTITUTIONS – When an animal has been duly entered and catalogued in any class the substitution of another animal will not be permitted.

PROTESTS – Any protest must be made, in writing, within 30 minutes of the completion of the judging of the specific class, signed by the protester and delivered to the Show Secretary.

The protester shall, at the time of making such protest, lodge the sum of \$100.00 cash (No cheques) which shall be forfeited to the Society should the objection be considered frivolous or vexatious.

All protests will be determined by the Judicial Committee whose decision shall be absolutely final.

FORBIDDEN SUBSTANCES

The use of tranquilisers, stimulants, or any drugs capable of affecting the performance of horses and ponies are forbidden.

Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the show and that testing of all animals is at the owner's risk. Testing for Forbidden Substances will be carried out under the RAS Judicial Committee procedures and rules. (Rule 89 RAS Equestrian Competitors & judges Rule Book.

Forbidden Substance Fee: This is incorporated into the entry fee and will not be collected separately

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY PTO.....

Protective Headgear

In all cases current WorkSafe rules prevail.

A hard hat is generally described as a hunting cap, a bowler, protective headwear or a safety helmet. Wearing a hard hat is compulsory for anyone competing on, working in or schooling, or riding for any other reason an exhibit at an RAS affiliated Show/Event or in any area considered to be for whatever reason a part of the Showgrounds.

All riders, including harness drivers, competing at RAS affiliated A&P Shows/Events must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened when in the arena or ring, the practice area collecting rings or anywhere else within a Showgrounds. Hats/helmets must conform with one of the current approved safety standards. These standards may be subject to change but the latest list can be found at <http://www.ras.org.nz> – equestrian. RAS will advise any changes via their website and Facebook.

Ages of Riders & Handlers

Rider/Handler's age and eligibility is determined as per the 1st August i.e. Riders/Handlers who are of age for any division/section on the 1st August complete the show year/season in that division/section.

Lead Rein classes are restricted to riders under eight (8) years of age with a minimum age of four (4) years, who are not competing in any other sections at any A&P Show/Event. To be led by an attendant fourteen (14) years of age or over.

First Ridden Classes are restricted to riders under ten (10) years of age, who are not competing in any other sections at any A&P Show/Event.

Novice pony exhibits (except Novice Pony Stallions) may be ridden by a rider of any age, in novice pony classes only.

Novice pony stallions must be let or ridden by a rider fourteen (14) years and over.

Open pony exhibits must be ridden by riders under seventeen (17) years of age.

Open pony stallions must be ridden by a rider fourteen (14), or fifteen (15), or sixteen (16) years of age, led handlers must be fourteen (14) years and over.

Riders in horse rings (exhibits over 148cm) must be twelve (12) years and over.

Stallions over 148cm must be led or ridden by a rider seventeen (17) years of age or older.

Young stock must be led by a handler fourteen (14) years and over.

Ages of Ridden Exhibits

Exhibits under three (3) years of age are not permitted in any ridden or driven (harness) class no matter what the rules of any affiliated Breed Society or Kindred Society may prescribe.

**CONDITIONS OF ENTRY: COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING
YELLOW CARD SYSTEM**

Kumeu Show supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system, which operates in the Equestrian Section of all RAS affiliated Shows and will be offered for any inappropriate behaviour toward Show Officials, Judges, Fellow Competitors or any other third party connected with the Show bringing the Equestrian discipline into disrepute, or cases which are of a less serious nature to the above in accordance with the conduct of members, Owners, Lessees, Competitors and/or Exhibitors as provided in the RAS Equestrian Competitors and Judges Rule Book and Rule 13 of the Constitution. Implementation of the 'Yellow Card' will be in accordance with the RAS rules that accompany this card. Full wording of the Yellow Card' system is available to view on the RAS website.

- No parking' areas must be strictly adhered to.
- Lunging not permitted inside the Oval
- Competitors must wear appropriate attire in all equestrian sections. Full dress description for each section refer RAS Equestrian Competitors and Judges Rule Book available from The Secretary Northern District RAS, PO Box 3 Whangarei
- Equines three years and under cannot compete under saddle.
- Stallions must wear an appropriate 2 x 'S' on their head gear. Stallions must be tied up securely either in stalls or vehicles when not in the show ring or being paraded. When in the show ring all stallions must be under strict control and supervision, a safe distance from the animals in front and to the rear must be adhered to.
- All stallions and colts (with exception of Miniature horses and foals) must be shown in a bit.
- A Steward will order any stallion/colt considered out of control or to be causing undue disquiet to other horses from the ring without recourse from the stallion/colt's owner/exhibitor/competitor.
- It is compulsory for all stallions and colts, except foals, to wear two (2) official "S" identification badges, one attached to each side of their bridle, at all Shows/Events at all times. The rider must also wear two RAS official (2) armbands (one on each arm) when in the ring. "S" badges to be purchased from RAS Head Office or ESNZ; armbands from RAS Head Office.
- Handlers and Riders of stallions/colts must wear an approved Hi Viz vest at Shows/Events when outside the showing ring. Vests can be purchased from RAS Head Office.
- Flat Ponies or Horses cannot compete in Flat Saddle Hunter Classes or Riding Horse Classes and Vice Versa.
- In the case of one rider qualifying two Horses or Ponies for Supreme Champion a substitute rider will be allowed. The substitute rider must ride same Horse/Pony throughout.

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident / illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the show grounds.

Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992. No person is permitted in any judging ring without express permission of the head steward of that ring. Only persons directly responsible for an exhibit are permitted in the marshalling area.

Classes missed are exhibitor's responsibility.

Late Exhibitors will be excluded from classes.

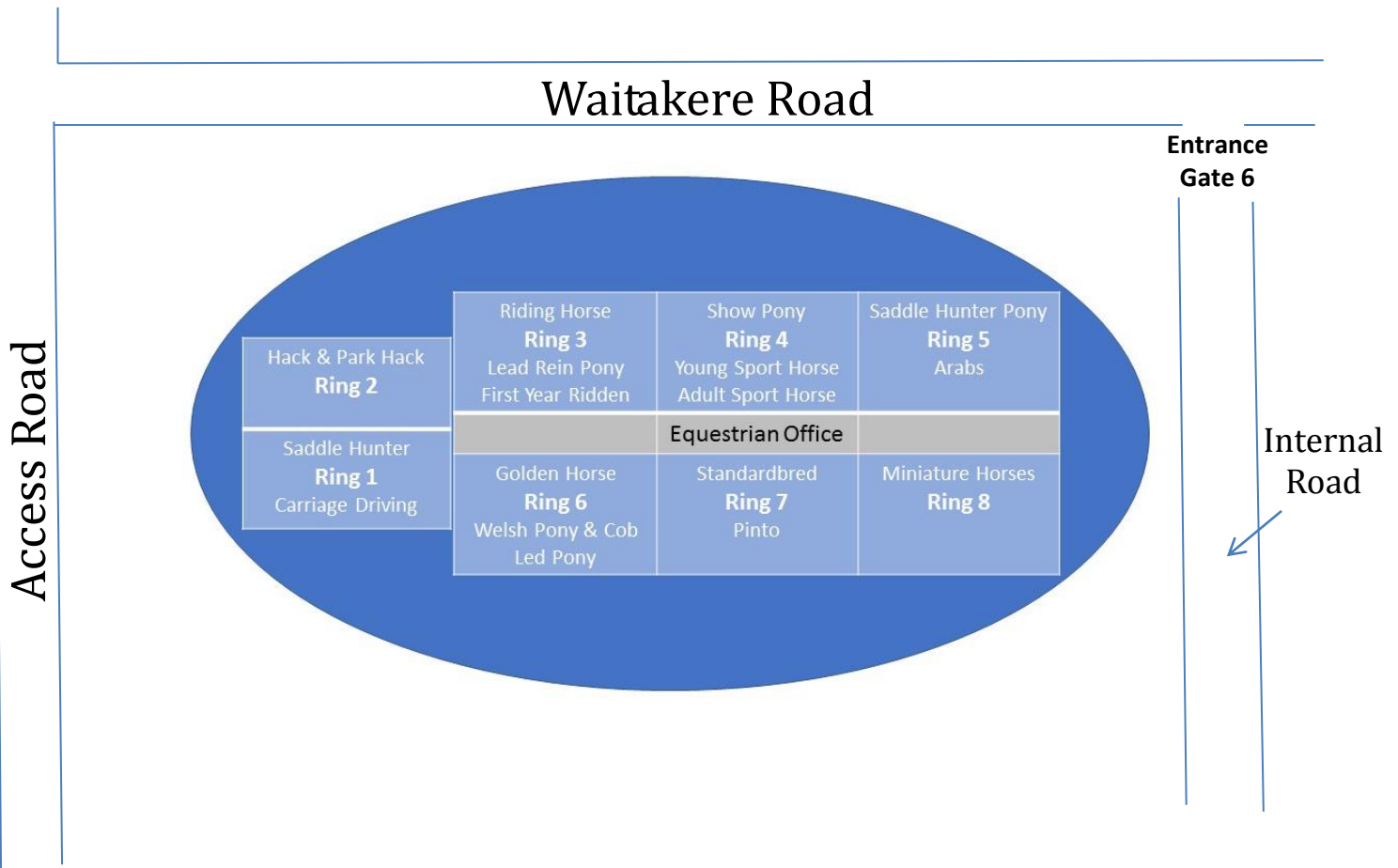

Spurs are not allowed.

A cane or a whip not exceeding 68cm in length, which includes a flap 2cm wide by 4cm long, may be carried by riders in the Lead Rein Section.

Judging Criteria: Judged on – 60% suitability, temperament and safeness – 40% conformation and paces.

Riders will not be asked to canter.

A best on parade, best turned out or unity class is the only competition within this section when the costume or dress of the leader may also be taken into account.

Riders who have competed in the First Ridden, Novice and Open Pony Sections are no longer eligible for the Lead Rein Section.

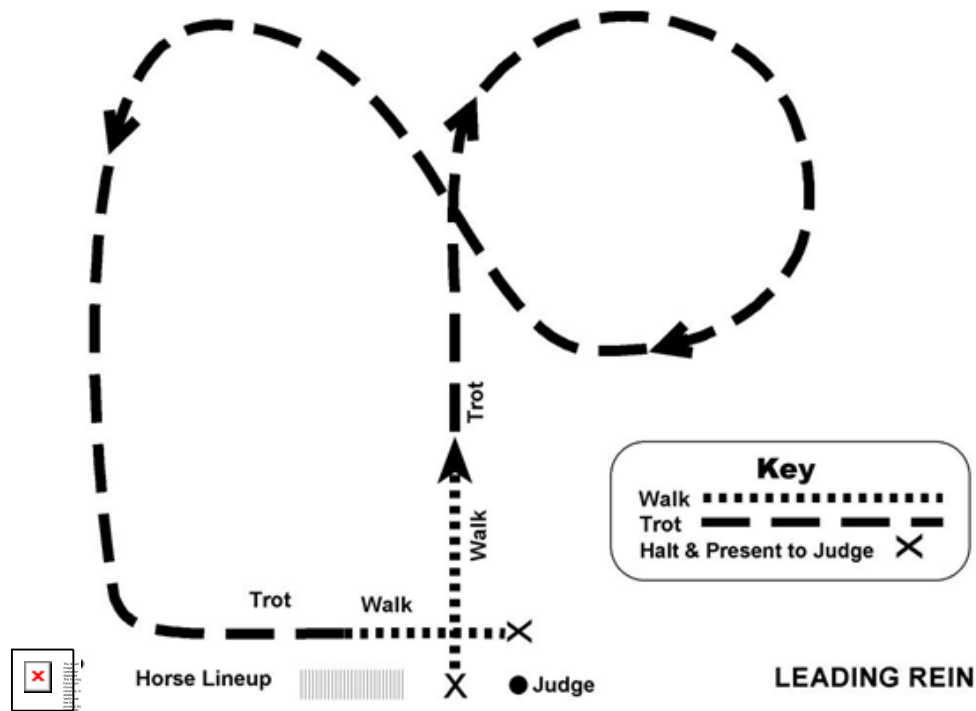

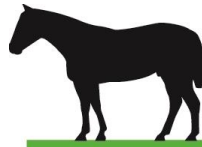
