Judging - Commences at 10:00am

Penning - Goats must be penned before 9:30am and required to stay until 3:00pm.

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident / illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the show grounds.

Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992

No person is permitted in any judging ring without express permission of the head Steward of that ring. Only persons directly responsible for an exhibit are permitted in the Marshalling area.

Declaration of CAE STATUS: If this panel is not completed on the Entry Form, entries will be penned with those of Unknown Status

All Dairy Goat exhibits must be registered or recorded with an RAS Affiliated Organization at time of entry and the Registration Number must be written on the entry form.

Goats must be tattooed or micro chipped. All exhibits must lead and tie up.

Does in milk will not be penalized if it is necessary to ease the udder before judging.

Does may NOT be stripped out in the ring.

All details requested must be completed on the Entry Form

No Dogs other than Competition, Display or Dogs Allowed by Legislation are allowed on the Kumeu A & H Society Show Grounds

*Two daughters in milk, of the same Sire but different Dams.
The name of the Sire and Dams to be given on the entry form*
- 3018 Dam & Daughter 1 or 2 Daughters. Daughters to be bred by the exhibitor
- 3019 Sire & Progeny 2 Progeny. At least one must be a Female
- 3020 Herd Register Type & Production
- 3021 Associated Record Type & Production
- 3022 Herd Register Best Udder
Open to all in milk does who have borne a kid. To be judged when full and again when stripped out. Does must be finally stripped out prior to entering the ring.
- 3023 Associated Record Best Udder
Rules as for Class 3022
- 3024 Junior Showmanship for young person's 15 years or under **The McMillan Trophy**
To be judged on the exhibitors ability to lead, place, turn, stop & start their goat and to answer two questions. Show preparation and appearance of both the exhibitor and goat to be taken into account. The level of NZDGBA achievement must be written on the Entry Form. e.g. Level is Bronze
