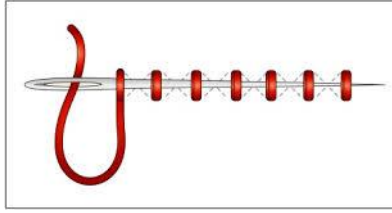

Cleats must be used. May be a set of runners, etc. under base board. Should not be obvious.

May be painted or covered with material or paper.

Where the schedule calls for a cake, a "dummy" or block may be substituted. Dummies should only be allowed to mimic real cakes, i.e. they should never be used in ways that are unrealistic tiering or shapes. Cakes will not be cut.

All work must be the work of the competitor and completed within the last 12 months.

Tier - A tier is defined as a layer or level of cake. They may be separated by pillars or stands or they may be stacked one on top of the other.
